

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
FLORIDA NONPROFIT CORPORATION

ARTICLE I

CORPORATE NAME

The name of this corporation is Orange Park Amateur Radio Club, Incorporated.

ARTICLE II

DURATION

The term of existence of this corporation is perpetual. The corporate existence will commence on the filing of these articles by the Department of State.

ARTICLE III

PURPOSES

The purposes for which this corporation is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary, and educational within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law. One of these purposes of this corporation shall be to foster and engage in all good communications, development, scientific, educational and charitable activities related to amateur radio transmissions and control, both philosophical and mechanical and the relationship of amateur radio operators to each other, to the commercial media as well as with governmental agencies such as the Federal Communications Commission.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1985, as amended or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of this corporation will be turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in Section 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or to the Federal, State or local government for exclusive public purpose.

**ARTICLE IV**

**TRUSTEES**
